BY AIR:

Air travel is a very convenient option for getting to Philly. Philadelphia International Airport hosts direct flights to and from many U.S. and international cities, and the airport is well-connected to the rest of the city--including Temple University--by the SEPTA Airport Line.

To take the Airport Line, purchase a Quick Trip for \$6.75 (one-way) from one of the vending machines at the platform. Be sure that you are on the platform that goes toward Center City, and get off the train at the Temple University stop. If you want to stop at your hotel or Airbnb first, you can easily do so, as the train stops at several Center City (downtown) stops, including 30th Street Station, Suburban Station, and Jefferson Station. We highly recommend the Airport Line, as it is very convenient and MUCH cheaper than taking an UBER, Lyft, or taxi from the airport.
